### What is the Multicentre study of self-harm?

The multicentre study of self-harm (MCM) conducts studies on the epidemiology, causes, clinical management and outcome of self-harm. It has been named the number one indicator for self-harm in England (Public Health England, 2014).



### Findings with significant clinical implications

The MCM produces clinically essential knowledge relating to the understanding, treatment, policies and prevention of premature death, in relation to self-harm. It contributes to National strategies and practice guidelines e.g. Suicide Prevention Strategy for England, (2012), NICE guidelines (2004, 2011).



### Conference aims and target audience

The conference will share and discuss the MCM study's findings and their clinical implications. It is suitable for anyone who may experience self-harm within their professional role, e.g. clinicians, researchers, service providers, policy makers, charities, school teachers, support workers, police.
