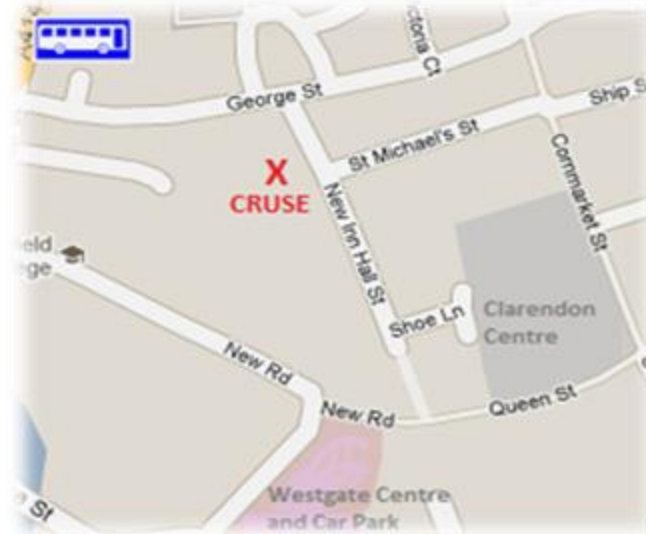
Somewhere to turn when someone dies
